[VI Frontiers in CardioVascular Biomedicine \(FCVB\) congress, 29 April-1 May 2022, Budapest, Hungary](#)

The sixth edition of Frontiers in CardioVascular Biomedicine (FCVB) will take place in Budapest from 29 April-1 May 2022. In keeping with our mission to support young scientists, the European Society of Cardiology (ESC) Council on Basic Cardiovascular Science (CBCS) and the European Section of ISHR are delighted to be able to provide 4 travel grants (600 Euros per grant) to young members of ISHR-ES. These grants will be awarded to the best scored abstracts. Recipients must be within eight years of their terminal degree (e.g. PhD, MD or MSc) at the time of the FCVB Congress. Recipients must be the first author and presenter of an abstract submitted to the FCVB 2022 Congress in Budapest. 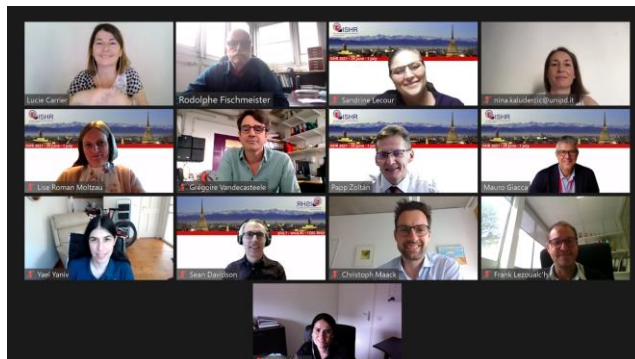
