2025 World Congress ECI Travel Awards

Please note that the deadline to apply for ECI Travel Awards has been extended to 15th March 2025!

ISHR International has announced the availability of **2025** World Congress Early Career Investigator (ECI) Travel Awards for qualifying applicants from all participating ISHR Sections. The awards for ECI from Europe are for \$1,500.

Requirements for the awards are:

- Each recipient must be a **paid member** of an ISHR Section*. Preference will be given to those who were members in 2024 and before.
- Recipients must be graduate students or within 8 years of their terminal degree (e.g. PhD or MD) at the time of the World Congress (May 11, 2025).
- Recipients must be the first author and presenter of an abstract submitted to the World Congress.
- Recipients of Travel Bursaries and Richard Bing Young Investigator finalists are not eligible for Travel awards (i.e. they cannot combine travel awards with the travel support provided for these other awards).

To apply for a Travel Award, eligible ECIs should:

Send an email confirming their eligibility and 1) a copy of a first-authored abstract that has been submitted to the World Congress and 2) a biosketch documenting that they are a student or within 8 years of their terminal degree (e.g. PhD or MD) as a single pdf (titled: Travel_Award_2025 – LastName) to the Executive Secretary (<u>llobaugh@ishrworld.org</u>).

Successful applicants will be notified in March, 2025.
